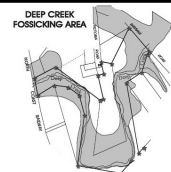

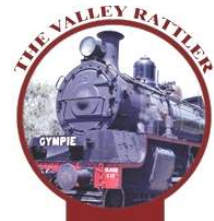

Gympie is home to Queensland's first licensed pubs brought on by the Gold Rush. License number 2 is still proudly displayed over the door of the Apollonian Hotel which was originally in Gympie and has since been moved to Boreen Point near Noosa. In fact, licences 1 through 11 were issued in Gympie with three of those licenses still operating. The oldest license still on the original site is the Imperial Hotel on the main street, 1868, license 3. The oldest original Building is the Mount Pleasant Hotel 1870. Gympie had many more pubs in its heyday with 48 pubs having opened in town, 28 being open at the same time.
